

Jester and Treasurer, Ten Leaders on Executive Coaching, a publication of the Association of Business Coaches (2007).

This book describes the development of modern leadership and what professional coaching executive coaches can contribute to this development. The concept of coaching is now a very broad sense and therefore has lost expressiveness. Thus the importance of leadership coaching explained on the basis of nine interviews with business leaders, men and women in various stages of their careers. They have their professional development with an executive coach and worked mostly still do.

In addition, an extended interview recorded with Manfred Kets de Vries, founder of the INSEAD Global Leadership Centre (Fontainebleau), on the development and importance of coaching at this time. Finally, the reader finds the impact of two focus groups of authors, led by Erik van de Loo, about the dilemmas of coaching. It will also be addressed to their motivations, after a long and varied career in business, the profession of executive coaching skills.

This book is written from the desire of the authors that young and older managers in business, management advisory and management receive assigns, take advantage of this relatively new form of support. The interviews in this book speak for themselves thereto.
